Job Summary: This position is responsible for enforcing state laws and county ordinances within the Tobesofkee Recreation area.

Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Enforces state laws and county ordinances within the Tobesofkee Recreation Area.
2. Patrols all areas on a regular basis to include parks, camping areas, beaches, boat ramps, Lake Tobesofkee Area.
3. Issues citations and makes arrest for violations of state laws and county ordinances.
4. Investigators boating accidents, motor vehicle accident, and additional accidents within the Tobesofkee Recreation Area.
5. Investigates and takes reports on crimes committed with the Tobesofkee Recreation Area.
6. Conducts search and rescue efforts on the water and within the surrounding areas.
7. Assists with the supervision of lifeguards during the summer season; may be responsible for site life guard program.
8. Assists Lake Tobesofkee personnel with office duties as needed.
9. Responds the complaints from Tobesofkee Recreation Area property owners and visitors to lake property.
10. Maintains all issued equipment including gate house camera systems.
11. May oversee site water testing program; may serve as the site's safety officer.
12. Assists with inventory check of all equipment assigned to Law Enforcement Rangers.
13. Must complete a minimum of 40 hours of POST training classes each year.
14. Testifies in court as needed.
15. Performs other related duties as assigned.

Minimum Qualifications:

1. High School Diploma or equivalent GED; with law enforcement experience/training.
2. Must be POST certified or possess the ability to become POST certified within the first year of employment.
3. Ability to meet current requirements set forth by the Peace Officers Standards and Training Council for the State of Georgia.

4. Knowledge of state criminal laws, state boating laws and county ordinances.
5. Knowledge of law enforcement processes, including arrests.
6. Knowledge of applicable state of federal laws and county and department policies and procedures.
7. Knowledge of first-aid and CPR techniques.
8. Skill in operating power boats and other watercraft.
9. Skill in the use of firearms, communications equipment, photographic equipment, and other standard and specialized equipment.
10. Skill in the use of physical restraint methods and equipment.
11. Skill in interpersonal relations.
12. Skill in operating emergency vehicles.
13. Skill in oral and written communication.
14. Must be able to swim.

Working Conditions:

1. The work is typically performed outdoors where the employee may be exposed to cold or inclement weather.
2. The employee may be exposed to noise, dust, dirt grease and machinery with moving parts.
3. The work is typically performed with the employee sitting, standing or walking.
4. The employee must be able to restrain people, lift light or heavy objects, use tools requiring a high degree of dexterity and distinguish between shades of color.
5. Fast-paced environment with changing priorities.
6. High activity, multiple deadlines, constant interruptions.
7. High visibility of behavior.
8. Travel between several parks and facilities daily.
