



GENERAL RUNOFF ELECTION

DECEMBER 4

In-person advance early voting for the December 4, 2018 General Runoff Election will begin on **Monday, November 26th**, and end on **Friday, November 30th**, at the **Macon-Bibb County Board of Elections Office** located at 2525 Pio Nono Ave. Suite 1200 Macon, GA 31206. Office hours are 8:30 a.m. – 5:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. There will be no Saturday or Sunday voting for the runoff election. On Tuesday, December 4, 2018, Voters will have to report to their designated polling location in order to vote.

Absentee ballot clerks began processing absentee ballot request on November 21, 2018. **Elderly and Disabled voters that received a mail ballot for the November 6, 2018 General Election** will automatically receive a General Runoff ballot. **All others desiring to vote an absentee ballot by mail will need to request and return an absentee ballot application as soon as possible.** Absentee ballot applications are available at the Board of Elections office and on their website: <http://www.maconbibb.us/project/board-of-elections/>. Email request can be made to: absentee@maconbibb.us. The deadline to request an absentee by mail ballot is Friday, November 30, 2018 by the close of business 5:30 p.m.

Important Facts:

- On Election day, voters must vote at the polling location where they are registered.
- Voters will need to provide photo I.D.
- Only voters who reside in Macon-Bibb County may cast their ballot at an assigned polling location.
- Contact the Board of Election to inquire about your assigned polling location.
- The registration deadline to vote in the December 4, 2018 Runoff Election was October 9, 2018.
- Eligible voters who did not vote in the November General can vote during the December Runoff Election.
- Voters are not required to vote by party affiliation in a General Election.
- There are no cell phones, cameras or other electric equipment permitted to be used within the polling location.
