The Plan's submission enables local governments receiving federal grants to combine short-term objectives, resources and projects into one planning document. The Plan is updated annually to reflect the funding decisions for each year. The Plan includes the PY18 Budget and Activity Summary for CDBG, HOME and ESG.

If a substantial change occurs in the budget during the budgeting process, an additional comment period will be required. The current definition of substantial change is the addition or deletion of projects and/or a decrease or increase of funding by more than 20%.

There will be a **PUBLIC MEETING** on **Thursday, June 21, 2018 at 4:00 p.m.** in the conference room located on the **4th Floor of the Terminal Station, 200 Cherry St, Macon, GA 31201** to discuss the above-listed proposed projects and obtain public input for the Action Plan.

The Action Plan is available for review until July 6, 2018 at the ECDD office located at the above address between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
