

# PROVISIONAL VOTER INFORMATION

On the morning of Tuesday, November 13, 2018, U.S. District Court Judge Amy Totenberg ordered, among several items, that the Secretary of State's Office direct every county election superintendent to publicize the Secretary of State's free access hotline and website on the county and county elections office's websites for provisional ballot voters to determine whether their ballots were counted and if not the reason why.
