Re: INVITATION FOR BIDS: 21-041-FL, City Hall Traffic Division Interior Renovation

The Invitation for Bids, referenced above, is modified as follows:

- 1. Have any reports or a Hazardous Material Survey been conducted to determine the extent of the abatement?
 - No.
- 2. Is there a basis of design for the new acoustical ceiling tiles? Model Number, Square or Tegular Edge, CAC rating or any specifications?
 - Radar 2110.
- 3. Will the paint scheme be 1 color for all walls and 1 color for all trim?
 - Yes, color supplied by owner.
- 4. Is there a basis of design for the new LVT flooring? Style, thickness, color?
 - 20 Mil wear layer Rigid Core color supplied by owner.
- 5. Should an allowance be issued to keep all contractors on a level playing field for the purchase of the LVT flooring? Example \$2.50 per sq ft of LVT flooring.
 - We believe most prices will be comparable with specs.
- 6. Is the rubber base to be 4 inches?
 - Has been changed to Vinyl. Yes, 4 inches.

- 7. Are we to include replacing the bathroom accessories we are told to demo in the bathrooms? (soap, paper towel, toilet paper dispensers)
 - No, New ones will be supplied and installed by owner.
- 8. Are we to include new cabinetry where we are told to demo the existing? If so, please provide more information on desired materials we are to use.
 - No.
- 9. On the bid form, there is a blank for "Time Line for Project." In the ITB, section P number 6 states, "The work shall be completed within 90 calendar days from the date of Purchase Order issuance". The ITB also list \$150/day liquidated damages. Please advise if the contractor is to provide a project duration or the ninety (90) days listed is to be used.
 - Owner will work with contractor on timeline.
- 10. Is work on weekends allowed?
 - Yes.
- 11. Will the space be occupied?
 - No, it is not occupied.
- 12. Is the contractor responsible for moving and resetting any furniture?
 - No.
- 13. Will building permit fees will be waived?
 - Inspections and permits required; fees waived.
- 14. From reading the scope of work provided, confirm we are not to replace any electrical fixtures or outlets or switches.
 - That is correct.
- 15. Are there any specs for interior wall paint?
 - All Masonry Epoxy.
 - All Metal Enamel.
 - Doors Latex.
 - Valspar Signature or equivalent.
- 16. Are there any specs for paint regarding the doors and door frames?
 - All Metal Enamel.
 - Doors Latex.
 - Valspar Signature or equivalent.
- 17. Are there any specs for new LVT?
 - 20 Mil wear layer Rigid core. (Submit for approval)
- 18. Are there any specs for new rubber wall base?
 - This has been changed to Vinyl.
- 19. Are there any specs for new ceiling tile regarding Main Room and Offices?
 - Radar 2110

- 20. Are there any specs for interior wall primer?
 - Zinsser bond or equivalent
- 21. Are there any specs for new paper dispenser?
 - Supplied and installed by owner.
- 22. Are there any specs for new soap dispenser?
 - Supplied and installed by owner.
- 23. Are there any specs for new paper towel dispenser?
 - Supplied and installed by owner.
- 24. Are there any specs for new lavatory mirror?
 - Commercial grade similar size 24x36. (Submit for approval)
- 25. Are there any specs for new lavatory sink and faucet?
 - Same size white porcelain.
 - Zurn Faucet (Submit for approval)
- 26. Are there any specs for paint regarding the ceiling grids?
 - Valspar signature or equivalent. Latex is OK.
