Re: INVITATION FOR BIDS: Roof Replacement Bid # 21-056

Questions and Answers

- 1. Are there additional plans other than the Scope of Work listed in Bid# 21-056-LH for roof replacement? Answer: No other plans are available.
- 2. Can a substitute include Johns Manville instead of the Carlisle brand? Answer: No substitutions for Carlisle materials allowed.
- Is the address listed on the bid (#21-056-LH) for the pre-bid conference meeting the actual site for the roofing repairs? Answer: Yes. Facilities Management Department of Macon Bibb Government at 1000, 7th St., Macon, GA 31201.
- As a licensed State of Georgia Contractor, do you have to be licensed with Macon-Bibb County to do business?
 Answer: If vendor is licensed to conduct business in the State of Georgia, they are eligible to do business with Macon Bibb County, Georgia.
- 5. The roof is to receive new gutters that are 8" wide. Please confirm or advise. Answer: Current gutters measurements are 8" wide x 10" deep.
- The roof is to receive new downspouts every 20LF and the downspouts are to be 5" x 4". Please confirm or advise.
 Answer: Down sprouts should be spaced 20' apart. Down Sprouts are 4" x 5."
- 7. Are we allowed to use 24-gauge steel for all roof areas needing metal? Answer: Yes, 24-gauge steel is acceptable.
- 8. Is the Carlisle brand a locked spec? Answer: Yes.

- 9. Is it a requirement to attend the pre bid conference to bid this project? Answer: Yes.
- Due to material shortage, it was said during the site visit that we would have much longer than the 2 months specified in the SOW to complete the project. How long will the awarded contractor be given to complete the project?
 Answer: Please refer to Addendum 1 that has been posted on the Macon Bibb County website.
- 11. What are the work hours and is weekend work allowed? Answer: Work hours can begin at 7:AM and end at 5:00 PM, Weekend work will be allowed if necessary and scheduled in advance.
- 12. Where on site is access as well as storage of materials? Answer: The Facilities Management designated personnel will determine and agree on adequate storage of material upon award.
- 13. Is the termination side bar inside the gutter to be installed in lieu of drip edge or are we required to install a termination bar inside the gutter and drip edge as well? Answer: The termination side bar will be sufficient no drip edge necessary.
- 14. Are bid bonds, performance, and payment bonds required? Answer: Yes. Bid bond should not be less than five (5%) percent and must accompany bid submission. The bidder to whom award is made, shall submit a Payment Bond and a Performance Bond, both in the amount one hundred (100%) percent of the contract price.

Please incorporate this change into the Invitation for Bid and acknowledge receipt of this addendum on your bid form.
