Scope of Work

Macon Bibb County Interstate Landscape Proposal for I-75 Exit 162 (GA Hwy 80/Eisenhower Pkwy) and I-75 Exit 172 (Bass Rd)—Long Term Maintenance Plan

Tasks:

- Weekly watering of new plant material to be done from March-November,
 ¼ of watering applications will include a root-booster/stress reliever
 (Superthrive, Nutriroot)—All watering and fertilizer applications will be supervised by Macon-Bibb County Forester
- Mowing to be completed 46 times- Weekly during Spring and Summer,
 Biweekly during Fall and Winter. These visits will include weedeating and
 weed spraying as necessary. All pesticide applications shall meet GDOT
 specs and will be supervised by Licensed Pesticide applicator.
- Mulching of new plant material will be completed once per year at a depth of 2" and will be done with a natural mulch of pinestraw.
- Pruning of new plant material will be done as needed to remove dead/diseased branches and provide clearance for mowing
- Dead plant replacements will be done as needed and in accordance with GDOT standards and during proper planting times.
- Litter control will be completed upon each visit

All aspects of this plan will be monitored by the Director of Macon Bibb Parks and Beautification, Macon Bibb County Forester, Licensed Pesticide Applicators and ISA Certified Arborist.

It is the intention of Macon-Bibb County to enter into a contract with a reputable landscape maintenance company for the completion of the above tasks. Macon-Bibb will partner with other agencies to provide funding for this maintenance contract.
