I. General

- A. The following clarifications, revisions, additions are hereby made a part of same, and shall be incorporated in the Project Manual, Drawings, and Work of the Contract the same as if originally included in the Bid and Construction Documents.
- B. <u>Bidders shall acknowledge receipt of this Addendum in writing, as provided on the</u> Transmittal Cover Sheet and the Proposal Form.
- C. When a revision and/or addition is called for to the Drawings or Project Manual, they shall be fully coordinated with and carried through all applicable Drawings and portions of the Project Manual, including in part, all related Civil, Electrical, and other Documents.

IV. Submitted Comments/Questions from Pre-Bid Conference held 6/2/2022 (with Response):

- 1. Question: Will a field office be required as part of this project?

 Response: Field office will not be required as part of this project.
- 2. Question: Can a GDOT state mix Asphalt be used instead of FAA Asphalt P-401?
 <u>Response:</u> As a federally funded project, FAA is requiring P-401 to be used for the Asphalt Mix as designed?
- 3. Question: Can the 10% Mobilization Max be increased?

 Response: Mobilization cost shall be limited to 10% of the total project costs. Any Mobilization costs over 10% of the project total must be thoroughly documented and will be only considered for payment on an as-incurred basis (with justification and proof of cost). Any non-incurred costs will not be paid. All cost over 10% shall be reviewed and approved by FAA and Sponsor at acceptance of Bid. No payment over the maximum 10% is guaranteed in a bid submission.

- 4. Question: Can we use a Non-Emulsified Asphalt Tack Coat in this project (as it is typically used on GDOT Related projects in the area)?
 - <u>Response:</u> In Section 603, 2.1 and 3.3 of the P-603 Specification, all references are to an Emulsified Asphalt Material for use on FAA related projects. No exceptions will be taken.
- 5. <u>Question:</u> Can bid date be moved back a week? Other large projects are bidding that date locally.
 - Response: Yes. The Bid Date will be Revised to Thursday, 6/23/2022.
- 6. Question: Please clarify how the project will be awarded? <u>Response</u>: Per Proposal Form Section, Page, PF-1, Determination of the lowest bidder will be based on the lowest bid received by a responsive, responsible bidder on the combination of Base and Alternate bids that are determined by the OWNER to be in its best interest. The OWNER reserves the right to contract for any combination of Base and Alternates stated or none of the above.
- 7. Question: From Note 6 on sheet 2D of the plan sheet, will the contractor be required to Bond roads outside airport property and be held responsible for all damages?
 Response: Revise note to say, "The location of access routes on the airport site are as shown and are subject to change. It shall be the contractor's responsibility to coordinate off-site access routes (state highways, local roads, or city streets) with the appropriate agency having jurisdiction regarding and permitting, safety and/or usage. All pavements inside the Airport property will be the contractor's responsibility for repair or replacement (if required) to pre-construction conditions resulting in damage from construction traffic use."
- Note of Clarification: Clarification by Engineer/Sponsor regarding use of Sweepers onsite
 during construction and airport policies applying to such.

 <u>Response:</u> Metal bristle sweepers shall <u>not</u> be used as part of this project. Past experience
 has yielded FOD issues related and therefore are omitted for use at the airport.
