The Executor or Administrator is required to advertise the Notice to Debtors and Creditors within 90 days of being appointed.

The Probate Court does not file the Notice to Debtors and Creditors. It is the responsibility of the Executor or Administrator.

A Notice to Debtors and Creditors must be published for four (4) weeks. Three (3) months must have elapsed from the date of last publication before a Petition for Discharge can be filed.

A copy of the Affidavit of Publication from The Telegraph <u>must</u> be filed with the Inventory if an Inventory is required. If an Inventory is not required, the Affidavit of Publication must be filed with the Court after publication or when a Petition for Discharge is filed.
