

Bibb County Probate Court Launches E-Filing

Bibb County Probate Court now accepts electronic filing through TrueFiling, a 24/7 web-based e-filing solution for courts, law firms, and self-represented filers. Payment of filing fees is also managed through the application.

To electronically file documents, users will need to create an account in the TrueFiling website: <https://tf3.truefiling.com/>

An e-filing fee will be charged by TrueFiling at the rate of \$14.00 per petition or caveat. A convenience fee will be charged by the credit card processing company of 3.25%. All statutory fees collected by Bibb County will remain unchanged.

Notice to E-Filers:

1. You must submit a Death Certificate in Will Probates, Administrations, and Year's Support Proceedings.
2. **Please do not submit the "Court Pages" portion of Any Petition**
 - a. Those pages start with a Notice that states: NOTICE THE FOLLOWING PAGES ARE TO BE COMPLETED BY THE PETITIONER (MOVING PARTY) UNLESS OTHERWISE DIRECTED BY THE COURT. SEE UNIFORM PROBATE COURT RULE 5.6 (A). (*Bibb County Probate will prepare these pages.*)
3. Original Wills must be filed with the Court within 10 days of e-filing.
