**ADDENDUM # 1**

To: ALL PROSPECTIVE FIRMS

Re: INVITATION FOR BIDS: 26-045-LH, Juvenile Justice Incentive Grant Program  
Functional Family Therapy Services

**The Invitation for Bids, referenced above, is modified as follows:**

1. There are limited FFT approved sites within the state of Georgia. Will Macon-Bibb consider alternative CJCC-approved evidence-based programs, or must proposals be limited to FFT?

Answer: Proposals limited to FFT – Functional Family Therapy only.

2. May the selected Management Entity also provide direct FFT services through its own proposed clinical team?

Answer: The selected Management entity can provide direct FFT services through its own proposed clinical team provided that the clinical team is EVIDENCED-based providers and meets the stated requirements and certification listed in the RFP.

3. Must clinicians be FFT-certified at submission, or may certification occur after award?

Answer: Must already FFT-certified – this would prevent an interruption of current services.

4. Who pays for FFT training, certification, licensing, consultation, and ongoing supervision?

Answer: The management entity/provider chosen is responsible and pays for certification, consultation and ongoing supervision.

5. What is the anticipated annual grant amount or maximum available program budget?

Answer: Grant budget has not been awarded. We are requesting bid information prior to grant award for competitive comparisons based on grant funds when awarded.

6. Are management, fidelity monitoring, reporting, provider coordination, and technical assistance costs allowable if built into the per-youth rate?

Answer: All listed is included ...cost per unit –(defined unit of service) = per youth cost with a management entity. Also, CJCC contracts with Carl Vinson Institute of Georgia (CVIOG) to monitor services/youth monthly.

7. Should pricing be submitted as cost per youth, cost per session, annual program cost, or another structure?

Answer: Per youth, and the number of youths to be served.

8. Are travel time, mileage, no-shows, court staffing, documentation, and collateral contacts billable?

Answer: No, they are not billable separately.

9. Are the Bid Bond, Performance Bond, and Payment Bond requirements applicable to this professional services solicitation?

Answer: No.

10. Can the County clarify the correct page limit (20 or 50) and whether resumes/forms count toward that limit?

Answer: Yes. Resumes and other response submittals are counted.

Please incorporate this change into the Invitation for Bid and acknowledge receipt of this addendum on your bid form.
