The Invitation for Bids, referenced above, is modified as follows:

1. There are a total of 680 Assets, with 543 being vehicles for street use, do you want the OBD II telematics device for the vehicles and battery powered asset trackers for all the other non-vehicle equipment?(The OBD II Device is the item that attaches to the vehicle's OBD port, this allows a fleet manager to monitor the vehicle's engine codes, speeding, braking, turning as well as location. A standard tracker essentially just provides GPS location and no other telematics data which is ideal for non-road use assets. Each product carries differing hardware and subscription costs)

Answer: Price both if possible

2. For the Vehicles, will you want a quote for the OBD II Device and a Camera or just the OBD II Device?(With a combination of a OBD II Device and Camera, in addition to the vehicle's use, the camera can help capture data in the event of a collision or other road-related events. Some cameras can also capture driver behaviors like tailgating, Eye Closing, Distracted Driving and Phone Use)

3. Will Macon-Bibb County have their own County Maintenance Technicians perform installs or do you need outside installers for the deployment?
