

NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

The Macon-Bibb County Commission has tentatively adopted a millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes by 9.28 percent.

All concerned citizens are invited to the public hearing on this tax increase to be held at Macon City Hall, 700 Poplar Street, Macon, Georgia, 31201, in the Commission Chambers on Wednesday, September 9th, 2026, at 9:00 A.M.

Times and places of additional public hearings on this tax increase are at Macon City Hall, 700 Poplar Street, Macon, Georgia, 31201, in the Commission Chambers on Friday, August 28th, 2026, at 12:00 Noon; Tuesday, September 1st, 2026, at 9:00 A.M.; and Tuesday, September 1st, 2026, at 6:01 P.M.

This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 9.575 mills, an increase of .813 mills. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than 8.762 mills. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$200,000 is approximately \$60 and the proposed tax increase for nonhomestead property with a fair market value of \$200,000 is approximately \$65.
